Bible-Based Fellowship Doctrinal Statement

We believe...

-  That the Godhead eternally exists in three persons—the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit—and that these three are one God, having precisely the same nature, attributes, and perfections, and worthy of precisely the same homage, confidence, and obedience.
-  Jesus is the Son of God, fully deity and fully human. He died for the sin of the world, was buried and raised from the dead the third day. He ascended to the right hand of the Father and will physically return to the earth to establish his kingdom.
-  In the authority and inerrancy of Scripture. We understand the whole Bible is inspired in the sense that holy men of God “were moved by the Holy Spirit” to write the very words of Scripture.
-  In the depravity of the human race and the need for all to be delivered from the power of sin. Salvation is obtained by grace through faith alone in the Lord Jesus Christ. He secured our eternal salvation through his substitutionary atonement and bodily resurrection.
-  The church is the bride of Christ. He is the head of the church, which is also his body.
-  In water baptism by immersion as a public declaration of an inward regeneration that has occurred.
-  The Holy Spirit indwells every believer and endows believers with spiritual gifts for the work of ministry and the edification of the body of Christ.
-  In the sanctity of marriage as a divine illustration of Christ and the church. It is the permanent union of one man with one woman as companions in life.
